Dear Parents

Campaigning for the green cause and imbibing values in students to nurture and protect the environment has always been a mission of our school. Taking this idea ahead, the school has endeavoured to engage students in a two-day residential summer camp to be held and organised by Tarumitra Ashram, XTTI, Digha Ghat, Patna. The theme of the camp is *Be cool, be organic and beat the heat by recycling plastic*. Tarumitra needs no introduction and has been a harbinger in bringing the denizens close to nature and promoting sustainability in our green environs. The aim of the summer camp is to involve the young minds in activities so as to make them forerunners in the green movement that the whole world is striving for.

The key points of the summer camp are given below:

- Students of classes VI IX are eligible for the camp.
- Two day and one night residential summer camp on 25th & 26th May, 2018 (Group A) OR 30th & 31st May, 2018 (Group B) at the Tarumitra campus.
- Cost per student for the two day camp is ₹500/-
- Provision of separate dormitories and washrooms for girls and boys.
- Pure vegetarian meals prepared with the organic produce from the Tarumitra gardens itself.
- Students are to report in school khadi uniform at 7 a.m. on day one and departure will be at 6 p.m. on day two. Parents must drop and pick them up from Tarumitra and carry the parent copy of the student I-card.
- Students are required to bring an additional set of school uniform/H&PE uniform, casual and comfortable clothes, salwar/kurta (girls) and kurta pyjama (boys) as night dress along with a towel, bedsheet, pillow cover, mosquito repellent and other toiletries as necessary for their personal use.
- Stationery items like pens, pencils, colours, a pair of scissors, cellotape and fevistick are also to be brought.
- Mobile phones, Camera, Ipods, e-devices, money, eatables and other valuable items will not be allowed.

During their two day stay at Tarumitra, they will be fruitfully involved in green activities like compost making, terrace and kitchen gardening, creating best out of waste and many other safe ecological practices. Most importantly, they will be acquainted with the Tarumitra ashram experience by being involved in the ashram chores. All the participants will be given certificates and outstanding performers will receive special awards on the closing ceremony of the camp.

As the camp is designed to house only 50 students, selection will be made on first come- first serve basis. Hence, you are requested to fill the consent form attached below and send it through your ward along with the payment of ₹500/- (in cash) which will be collected by a representative of Tarumitra who will be present in school campus on 10th and 11th May, 2018 during school hours. <u>Kindly note that consent form and payment will be collected only on the above mentioned dates.</u>
